

BEM Karol Kopel Jerzy (1894-1919), accountant, defender of Lwów. He was born on 8th November 1894 in Częstochowa, the son of Józef (3rd January 1865 Bolesławiec-), the owner of a hotel, and Salomea Chaja Sura née Reichman/Rajchman (20th October 1865 Częstochowa-), brother of → Aleksander.

On 10th January 1916, he joined the Polish Legions, serving as a soldier in the 2nd Infantry Regiment. In November 1918, he took part in the defence of Lwów. He died on 23rd March 1919 in Lwów and was buried in the Cemetery of the Defenders of Lwów. He was awarded the Cross of Independence.
