

**BERGMAN** Dawid (1800-1876), grain trader. He ran many businesses in Częstochowa and in the Częstochowa District [powiat]. He specialised in the sale of landed estates. In the 1840s, on a nine-year lease (together with his brother-in-law Moszek Weinreb), he owned Wyczerpy and the folwark Aniołów [Angels' farm]. In 1854, Aleksander Jawornicki, co-owner of Nowa Wieś near Częstochowa, entrusted Bergman with the sale of the property. In 1858, Bergman endeavoured to buy a tenement Częstochowie. In 1866, together with Szymon Bergman and → Szymon Böhm, he purchased the Radostków property from Aleksander Trzaskowski (for 52,800 rubles). In 1868, he bought out the entire property. He died in Radostków.

His wife was Estera (1812-1884) née Goldman, with whom he had a son Szymon Lewek Symcha (1829-1891) who, in 1851, married Szprynca Wolberg. They also had three daughters - Dyna (1825-), married name Wiener, Gitla (1827–1888), who married → Szymon Böhm from Krzepice, and Laja Eleonora (1840-), married to Salomon Königsberg.
