

BERGMAN Marta (1903-), advocate. She was born on 31st January 1903 in Częstochowa, the daughter of → Bronisław and Tauba née Herc, and sister of → Stefan.

In 1920, she graduated from the J. Słowacki State Girls' Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. In around 1926, she studied law at the University of Warsaw. In 1928, after completing a two-year internship, she passed the examination at the Court of Appeal. From that same year, she began her legal apprenticeship in Częstochowa. After passing the examination, on 8th July 1931, she was sworn in before the Warsaw Advocate Council. She practised in various cities. From 1933, she ran a legal practice in Częstochowa (at II Aleja 2). In 1936, she reported to the Advocate Council that she had moved her practice to Łódź. In 1938, she again ran a legal practice in Częstochowa (at II Aleja 22).

From 1935, her husband was the engineer Haltrecht from Łódź.
