BLUMENFELD Adolf (1883-), bookkeeper, administrator, manager of the food deputation district. He was born on 30^{th} October 1883 in Częstochowa, the son of Chil (1857-1918), a merchant, and Gustawa Gitla née Mendelsohn, previously Kohn (26th October 1854 Częstochowa-), brother of Dawid (1886-), \rightarrow Gustawa and Perla (1888-), married to Gustaw Weinberg.

He graduated from the government Boys' Gimnazjum in Częstochowa, and then from the Commerce Academy in Leipzig. He was a customs office despatcher in Herby. In 1909-11, he worked for the Riga Commerce Bank in Częstochowa. In 1912-14, he managed the Łódź branch of Leon Mendelsohn's Częstochowa company. From 12th August 1915, he was manager of the food deputation district of the Częstochowa municipal authorities. He was responsible for the grocery stores and bakeries. After 1920, he was a member of the board of the Commercial Workers Cooperative (offices on ul. Piłsudskiego).

Blumenfeld knew three languages - Russian, German and French. He lived at Nowy Rynek (pl. Daszyńskiego) 4.

His wife was Sura Liba née Szkulników (24th July 1887 Koło-). They had no children.
