

BRONIATOWSKI Chaskiel (1864-1943), merchant and entrepreneur, charity activist. He was born on 4th March 1864 in Częstochowa, the son of Eljasz (1833-1915) and Mariem née Finkelsztajn. Presumably, he is the same Ch. Broniatowski who, in 1913, ran a soap factory at ul. Nadrzecza 46. He lived at ul. Fabryczna 7 (Mielczarskiego). He was a member of the "Dobroczytność" Charitable Society for Jews.

In his marriage (from 1890) to Gitla née Glikson (the registry record incorrectly shows "Gliksman"), he had four sons - Leon (1893-), Ajzyk (1897-), Chaim (1911-) and Moszek (1914-).
