Enzel, Nathan (Chicago)

Son of Izrael and Chana; born on 25th October 1894 in Częstochowa. He married Lilia Sziper. Came to America in 1914. He is a member of the Chenstochover Educational Society in Chicago.

Essig, Abram

Died in 1908 in Częstochowa at the age of eighty-five. The grandfather of Itta Lenczner, NY.

Essig, Samuel (Cleveland, Ohio)

Epsztajn, Herszl (Los Angeles, Ca.)

He is a devoted and responsible activist who evokes recognition and respect.

He married Sura Szarogrod. His son served in the American navy.

Epsztajn, Sura (Los Angeles, Ca.)



Daughter of Izrael-Isser and Laja Szarogrod; born on 17th June 1891 in Nowo Radomsko. In the years 1903-1913 in Poland, she belonged to the SS Party. Came to America in 1913.
