**DORF** Izydor (1902 - circa 1942), lawyer. He was born on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 1902 Jarosław, the son of Adolf Abraham and Hana née Dürstenfeld.

He graduated from his legal studies and completed his internship. In April 1933, he was entered onto the attorneys' list of the in the Warsaw Bar Association, and chose Częstochowa to establish his legal practice. In that same year, he ran his Częstochowa practice at I Aleja 14). Up to 1939, he was mentioned, as a lawyer, in various listings, as a Częstochowa lawyer.

At the beginning of the German occupation, he lived at ul. Berka Joselewicza 6. On 2<sup>nd</sup> August 1940, he was arrested by the Gestapo in connection with the case of Lucjan Cwudziński. He was held as a political prisoner in the German Correctional Prison until 12<sup>th</sup> August 1940. He did not survive the occupation. On 30<sup>th</sup> December 1950, he was presumed dead by a decision of the Częstochowa Municipal Court.

His wife was Dorota.
