EPSTEIN Pinkus (1925 - after 2008) participant in the Treblinka uprising. He was born on 3rd March 1925 in Częstochowa.

He was deported to the Treblinka extermination camp, from Częstochowa, on 22^{nd} September 1942. There, for eleven months, he moved the bodies of victims in field No.2. His younger brother, Dawid, was also selected to work in the camp, but was later killed by an SS man. Following the outbreak of the uprising in August 1943, Pinkus fled and returned to Częstochowa, where he obtained "Aryan documents" and volunteered for work in Germany. In July 1948, he left for Israel. In February 1987, he testified at the trial of Treblinka guard John Demianiuk.
