FRANK Dawid (1875-1942), Jewish religious school owner. He was born on 15th July 1875 in Żarki, the son of Berek, owner of a *cheder* in Żarki, and Hana née Wajnrajch.

He received a religious upbringing, probably his initial education coming from his father. His religious education continued in yeshivas with rabbis in Wolbrom, Warsaw and in other Polish cities. At the age of twenty-five, he established and ran a Jewish religious school (*cheder*) in Częstochowa, located at I Aleja 8. The school premises consisted of two rooms. In 1927, he was granted a licence, with a restriction of up to twenty-five children. The school accepted younger children or those who had failed at school. Hebrew was taught by the owner, himself. General subjects were taught with the involvement of the head of the school. Frank's students exempt from compulsory education.

His wife was Gitla née Frank (1878 Kuźnica Stara - 1938 Częstochowa), the daughter of Herszlik and Anna Hena Estera née Baumac. She is buried in the Czestochowa Jewish Cemetery (grave No. 175 II). They had five children.
