FRENKIEL (FRENKLÓWNA) Jadwiga (1893-1940?), doctor. She was born on 24th April 1893 in Częstochowa, the daughter of → Maurycy Frenkel and Cecylia Celina Cyrla née Pinkus (1866-1922).

Frenkiel graduated from the girls' gimnazjum in Kraków. She obtained her secondary school certificate on 30th September 1912. From 1915, she studied in the Faculty of Medicine at the Jagiellonian University and received her discharge in 1925. In 1926, she received her doctor's degree in all medical sciences and began accepting patients. As a paediatrician, she worked in Kraków, running a private medical practice at ul. Krupnicza 14 and, in 1933-39, in Zakopane. (She lived at ul. Krupówka 77).

Following the outbreak of war with the Germans, in September 1939, she managed to get to the eastern part of Poland. She died in Lwów in 1940 (?) in unknown circumstances.
