GEBROWICZ Maurycy Mojżesz (1894-), Polish Legions soldier. He was born on 4th December 1894 in Częstochowa, the son of turner Simcha Gebrowicz, a resident of Chęcin, and Gołda née Dudkowicz.

In Częstochowa, he worked as a baker. On 6th December 1915, he joined the 2nd Brigade of the Polish Legions. He served in the 7th Company of the 2nd Infantry Brigade and took part in the fighting in Wołyn. On 26th February 1917, as an invalid and unfit for military service, he was dismissed from the Legions. In 1918-1920, he served in the Polish Army. He was awarded the Medal of Independence.
