**GLIKSMAN** Szaja (1904-), sports activist. He was born on 24th January 1904 in Częstochowa, the son of Mendel and Carka née Efroim.

Gliksman was a sports activist. From 1932, he served as president of the "Błyskawica" Jewish Workers' Sports Club and, in the second half of the 1930s, of the "Admira" Sports Club. In 1937, he became of member of the sub-division of the Zagłębie District Football Association.

He lived at ul. Narutowicza 25.

His wife was Miriam Peril née Berkowicz (11th April 1899 Częstochowa - 4th November 1931 Częstochowa), the daughter of Alter Moszek and Chaja Rachla née Tencer.
