

GLIKSMAN Zofia Zysła (1903-1942) teacher. She was born on 28th December 1903 in Częstochowa, the daughter of → Izydor Icchok Majer Mic and Sura née Działoszyńska.

After graduating from the Jewish Gimnazjum in Częstochowa, she studied history at the University of Warsaw. She returned to Częstochowa and, for two years, taught Polish and general history at the H. Sienkiewicz I State Gimnazjum. Later, she was transferred to the position of deputy head and teacher at the No.13 Comprehensive School on ul. Krakowska, where she worked together the director → Natalia Szacher until the outbreak of war She perished in Treblinka in 1942.

She was the first wife of → Wolf Glikzman. They had a son Itamar (1939-1941 Częstochowa or 1942 Treblinka).
