GÓRSKI Herszlik Cwi Hirsz (1802 or 1804-1863), merchant, entrepreneur, the son of Abraham.

As a weaving products entrepreneur, from 1832, he used the services of weavers in Częstochowa and Huta Stara. He owned a yarn store in Częstochowa (on ul. Mostowa). In the following years, together with his partner Izaak Winer, he gathered thirty-two weavers with whom he worked. In 1842, the plant, which belonged to him and to his partner (I. Winer), was sold for an amount of 1,801 rubles.

He died on 2nd May 1863 in Częstochowa and was buried in the Jewish cemetery (grave No. 1255A II).

His wife was Jetta née Tempel (circa 1807-1872 Częstochowa). They had four children:

- Bajla (17th April 1826 Częstochowa-),
- Dyna (2nd June 1829 Częstochowa-),
- Abram (1837 Częstochowa 1901 Częstochowa), married to Hena née Weksler (1840 Stopnica – 16th February 1922 Częstochowa), and
- Rebeka (1861 Częstochowa–).
