GOTTLIEB (GOTLIB) Abram Lejb (1890-), locksmith, worker activist. He was born on 14th December 1890 in Częstochowa, the son of Szlomo Mendel and Perla née Berkowicz.

By trade, he was a locksmith and belonged to the *Poalei Zion* workers' party. In 1919, he was a co-founder and, later, a member of the board of the "Strzecha" Workers' Cooperative in Częstochowa (located at I Aleja 1). In 1927, on the list of the Jewish Workers' Electoral Committee, *Poalei Zion* (list No. 5), he stood for election to the Częstochowa City Council. He was unsuccessful.

His wife was Ruchla née Rozenzon (15th December 1885-), the daughter of Szaja and Liba née Wajman. They had two children – a daughter Cypora (16th January 1913 Częstochowa-) and a son Jakub (19th October 1914 Częstochowa-).
