GRYNBAUM Maurycy (1887-), doctor. He was born on 7th March 1887 in Częstochowa, the son of trader Jakub and Ruchla née Tempel, and the twin brother of Adam

He graduated in medicine in 1913. At the end of the 1920s, he lived in Częstochowa, at ul. Piłsudskiego 15 (where he also had his medical practice). He specialised in childhood illnesses and internal medicine. Later, from circa 1927, he headed the Physical Treatment Centre, where he used electrotherapy.

At the beginning of the 1930s, he moved to Warsaw, where he lived at Aleja Jerozolimski 37. He continued to use physical therapy in his treatments.

The official German census does not record his presence in the General Government during the occupation.
