**HOCHERMAN** Gustaw Gimpel (1899–1942), lawyer. He was born on 31st October 1899 in Częstochowa, the son of Hendel and Dobra née Bryl.

On 1st April 1933, he applied to be released from his court internship and, in July 1933, he submitted a letter to the Bar Council in Warsaw for admission as an apprentice lawyer. In 1937, he completed his apprenticeship, passed the Warsaw Bar Council examination and was entered onto the register of lawyers, with an office in Częstochowa. He conducted his legal practice at al. Wolności 18 and, from July 1937 to 1939, at I Aleja 1.

During the German occupation, he lived in the Częstochowa ghetto. It was there that he was shot during the deportation of Jews (September-October 1942) to the Treblinka extermination camp.
