"Places for the young" – such a cry is heard all over the world. In line with this appeal, many countries are downsizing and officials are retiring early.

But, what about the free professions? Should there be competition until the end of their lives, even if it means a very long time?

In France, it was decided to regulate this matter legally, MP Pomaret submitted a motion into parliament prohibiting doctors from practising beyond the age of 65. This proposal was extended by a group of interested MPs such that the age limit for all professions is to be 65.

If this motion passes, all French the

doctors and lawyers, over the age of 65, will have to remove the plaques from their homes. There will be quite a number of them as we know that the French live long.

There have now been protests against this proposal — mostly amongst young people, namely the union of medical students in France. They correctly assume that an older doctor, mentally fit and experienced, provides much better service that a younger one.

The responsible editors of these magazines were accused of revealing details of investigations against the publisher and editor of the "Katholische Volkszeitung" in Rybnik, Artur Trunghardt.

What was revealed were the following court proceedings: indictment was raised in February last year, in the Katowice District Court, against Trunghardt, containing allegations of a number of punishable criminal offences.

For the publication of this record of indictment, the prosecutor in Katowice held the responsible editors of these magazines liable for the publication of this record prior to the trial.

After hearing from the defendants, who declare that they did not feel guilty, attorney Rappaport spoke, emphasising that it had long been the practice of announcing indictments in larger criminal cases. The announcement of the indictment did not constitute disclosure of the details of the investigation.

The provisions prohibiting the disclosure of investigations are intended to protect the progress of the investigations.

In this case, that issue is irrelevant.

Mountain jubilee

The 125th anniversary of the discovery of the Jungfrau – 80 victims of the queen of the Bernese Alps, Europe's highest railway station.

26th July, this year, marks the 125th anniversary of the famous Jungfrau, queen of the Bernese Alps.

The mountain which, in the new geological era, at least a few million years ago, slowly emerged from the waves of the Mediterranean Sea, which then covered a large area of today's Europe. 125 years ago, after overcoming many difficulties to reach its peak, its sublime beauty was discovered by the Meyer brothers, the sons of a silk manufacturer from Aargau.

Since then, "Madame Meyer", as the newly discovered mountain was jokingly called, remained unconquered for sixteen years.

It was only in 1828 that seven tourists managed to climb the mountain for the third time. And, again, over ten years passed until the climb, after which it happened more and more often.

In 1928, the first woman, an Englishwoman Winkworth, did it

with her husband, another man and three guides. And forty-four years later, ten-year-old Ida Liechti, daughter of the director of the Jungfrau cable car, managed to reach the summit.

Victims of the queen of the Bernese Alps were numerous — unlike those of any other mountain. Although the first disaster only occurred in 1872, since then it has claimed at least 80 lives.

Finally, we should also mention this pioneer, who made the white Jungfrau kingdom available to people, who would otherwise not be able to get there.

He is Adolf Guyer Zeller who, despite the pessimistic views of the technician, managed to turn, into a realty, his idea of a cable car to the Jungfrau peak. It is the highest railway station in Europe.

Construction of the railway began

in 1898 and was completed in 1912, after overcoming extraordinary difficulties.

A minute instead of two years

Near the town of Korkino, close to Chelyabinsk (USSR), in order to exploit deep coal seams, huge mines were laid, using 1,800 tons of explosives. The explosion threw up around one million cubic metres of earth. A deep gully was created, about a

20 metres deep and 85 metres wide. Using the usual methods in such cases, it would take a year to dig up such a large amount of earth or three years of intensive work. A special Academy expedition observed the shock caused by the explosion.

Czechoslovakia 17.1 million Swiss francs, Denmark 267,675 Danish crowns, France 2,204 million French francs, the Netherlands 323,700 florins, Norway 12 million Norwegian crowns as well as 934 pounds sterling, the United States of America 206 million US dollars, Switzerland 56,025 francs, Sweden 4.9 million Swedish crowns, Great Britain 4.6 million pounds, Italy 38 million lire.

The value of these inter-national war debts, owed to Poland, amounted to 2.01 billion zł.

In addition to war debts, there are also "liquidation debts" (from settlements with the former occupying powers), particularly, obligations after Austria.

Finally, the last item of Poland's foreign public debt are state treasury bonds, issued as aid to finance institutions. The value of this was 17, 442,900 zł.

The total of treasury guarantees is calculated by "Polska Gospodarcza" at 460 million zł. Therefore, there are liabilities being created. In total, our foreign debt would be 3.9 million złoty.
