

JOSZPE Chaskiel (1885–), craftsman, worker activist. He was the son of Aron.

In Częstochowa, Jozspe worked as a baker. He belonged to the underground of the Bund General Jewish Workers Union. He was arrested by the Russian military police on 11th July 1905 in Częstochowa. He was placed into Częstochowa custody and, later, was transferred to the provincial prison in Piotrków Trybunalski. He was accused of belonging to the Bund's military organisation and of shooting and wounding a policeman. He was arrested again in 1908, accused of belonging to the underground Zionist-Socialist Workers' Party.
