KARPF (KARP) Ludwik (1877–), industrialist, social and charity activist. He was born on 29th January 1877 in Aleksandrów, the son of Karol Kałma and Karolina née Mor (Mer), the brother of Zofia, married to → Aleksander Adam Wolberg.

He graduated in technical studies and was an engineer. From the beginning of the 20^{th} century, he was co-owner (together with \rightarrow Aleksander Adam Wolberg) of the "Zawodzie" Częstochowa Paint Factory (at ul. Mikołajewska 12).

He was engaged in charitable activities. He sat on the board of the "Dobroczynność" Charitable Society for Jews (TDdŻ) and, in 1908-1913, he was a member of the TDdŻ Hospital building committee.

His wife was Jadwiga Maria née Poznański (20th August 1880 Aleksandrów-), the daughter of Adolf and Regina née Wolkoff (?).
