

**KORNBERG** Salomon Szlama (1880–), co-owner of a brickworks. He was born on 20<sup>th</sup> June 1880, the son of Dawid (1835?-1897), a trader, and Frajdla née Willinger (who is buried in the Częstochowa Jewish Cemetery – grave No. 30 II).

From 1911, Kornberg, together with his brother Maurycy Mojżesz, ran a brickworks in Liszkace, near Gnaszyn (now in the Częstochowa district of Lisiniec). The brickworks office was at II Aleja 20 in Częstochowa (where the Kornberg family lived). In the 1920s, the brickworks was incorporated into the “Anna” Gnaszyński Ceramic Works. The Kornberg brothers were members of the board (together with → Zygmunt and → Roman Markowicz, as well as with → Izydor Sigman).

Kornberg’s wife was Estera. They had a son, Abram (23<sup>rd</sup> August 1907-).
