KURLAND Chaim (1910-), miller, Jewish policeman. He was born on 5th December 1910 in the mill settlement of Dąbie (now the district of Zawodzie-Dąbie, within the city of Częstochowa), the son of Herszlik (1885-1938) and Sura Ajdlai née Zelkowicz.

He graduated from the fifth grade of the Jewish Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. He completed his military service in a battalion of the Nowe Święciany Border Protection Corps. In 1939, he took part in the training of the 27th Infantry Regiment in Częstochowa.

From May 1941, he belonged to the Jewish Order Services – District No.2, Group A. He survived the war.
