

LIBERMAN Aron (1887–1942?), craftsman, Jewish self-government activist. He was born in Częstochowa, the son of Szmul and Sara.

He was a baker in Częstochowa. He belonged to the Central Union of Jewish Craftsmen. He served on the board of the Częstochowa Jewish Community Council. In 1927, representing the Jewish Craft Association, he stood for election to the City Council – he was unsuccessful.

During World War II, he was in Częstochowa and perished in the camp in Treblinka.
