LONDYŃSKI Rafał Jankiel (1842?-1894), cantor.

He was cantor in the city synagogue in Częstochowa. In 1874, together with  $\rightarrow$  Icze Rotholc and the baker Jeszaja Goldberg, he founded *Hachnasat Orchim* and the *minyan* at ul. Garncarska 7.

He died on 13<sup>th</sup> February 1894 in Częstochowa.

His wife was Temera Szyfra née Lew/Rabinowicz (1847 - 19<sup>th</sup> April 1920 Częstochowa), formerly Grylak. She came from Brześć Litewski, and is buried in the Częstochowa Jewish cemetery (grave No. 1853A I).
