MAJTLIS (Meitlis, Mejtlis) Paweł Pinkus (1900-1957), lawyer. He was born on 1^{st} July in Częstochowa, the son of \rightarrow Izrael and Judyta née Haftke.

From the school year 1910/1911, he attended the No. 1 Polish Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. On 30^{th} September 1927, he was released from his position as a court trainee and admitted as a trainee lawyer in offices at ul. Strażacka 13 (ul. Katedralna 8). In 1928, as a trainee, he worked in the law offices with lawyer \rightarrow Samuel Wajntraub and trainee \rightarrow Roman Lewkowicz. In 1930, he completed his training and passed the law examination before the Bar Council in Warsaw. He was appointed a lawyer with offices in in Częstochowa, at ul. Strażacka 13. In that same year, he reported that his offices were moving to Sosnowiec. There, until 1939, he ran a practice at ul. Małachowskiego 2a. In 1937, he was one of the founders of the Jewish Social Circle in Sosnowiec.

After the war, he moved to Israel. He died on 6th August 1957 in Tel Aviv.
