**MARGULIES** Wilhelm Wolf, actually Rubin Zew Nussbaum (1874–1942?), teacher. He was born on 7<sup>th</sup> August 1874 in Tarnopol, the illegitimate son of trader Henoch Margulies and Rachela Nussbaum (his parents married in 1904).

He began working as a teacher circa 1896. Initially, he lived in Sołotwin (Nadwórna County, Stanisławowskie Province) where, in 1903, he was head of Baron Hirsch's foundation's folk school. From 1926, he was director of the No.12 General School in Częstochowa, at ul. Wałach 14 (ul. Wilsona 14 and 16). He retired at the end of 1931.

He then became director of general schools for the Society of Jewish Secondary and General Schools in Częstochowa where he worked until June 1939. He was respected as a teacher and educator of children in a national Jewish spirit. In 1939, the Ministry of Education awarded him a medal of merit for his many years of fruitful work.

He lived at ul. Kopernika 11/15.

In 1903, he married Berta Weisman (1882 Stanisławów - ?), the daughter of Jakub and Debora née Walter. They had two sons:

- Stanisław Józef (11<sup>th</sup> May Stanisławów ?), living in Częstochowa at ul. Kopernika 11/15), and
- → Maksymilian Margulies.
