MAUER Izydor Izrael (1894–), doctor. He was born on 1st December 1894 in Częstochowa, the son of Jakub and Estera née Mokrauer.

He studied medicine, completing five semesters to 1920. He was called up to the Polish Army. In the sanitary service, he took part in the Polish-Bolshevik War. On 1st January 1921, he was promoted to the rank of second lieutenant. After being demobilised, he completed his medical studies, receiving his degree in 1927.

He ran an internal medicine practice in Warsaw. In 1939, at ul. Targowa 32 and, from circa 1941, at ul. Świętojerska 11.

His wife was Helena née Hamburger (14th September 1899 Warszawa-), the daughter of Abram and Liba Szajndla née Folman.
