

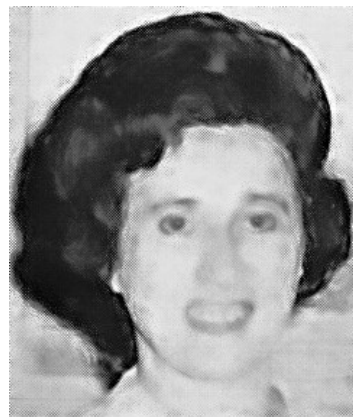
## Hanka (née Katz) Segal

The Katz family was very well-known in Częstochowa for their printing press and publishing a Yiddish newspaper.

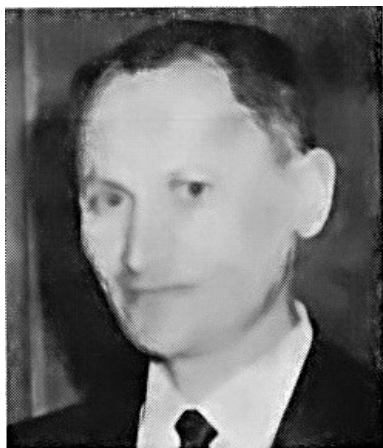
Hanka is the wife of Liber Segal - they have two daughters. They arrived in Montreal in 1948.

Liber was born to Mojsze and Henia (née Bab) in Wołyń [Volhynia] and, from 1932, lived in Częstochowa at ul. Targowa 25.

Before the war, he was an involved activist in the Bundist *Zukunft* youth organisation.

He arrived in Montreal in 1948, along with his wife Hanka Segal (née Katz).

Liber Segal participates in communal works and is an active member of the Czenstochover Landsmanshaft of Montreal.

Liber Segal passed away while this book was in printing, on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1965.
