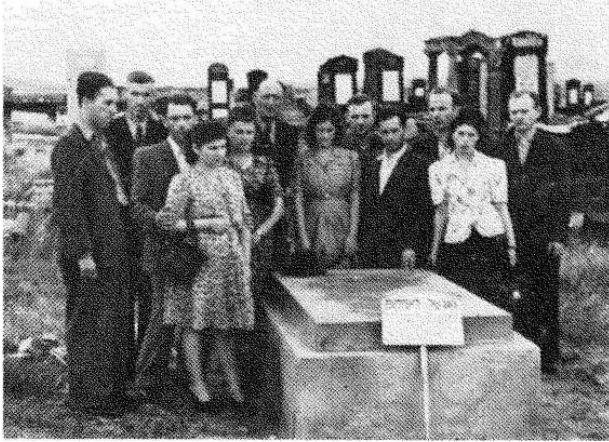

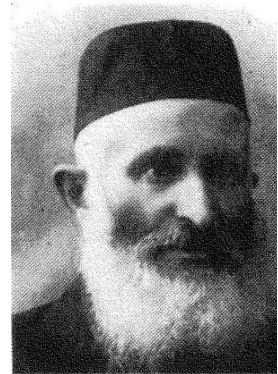
Before the War, he served in the Polish military
in the 36th [Infantry] Regiment named for
Marshal Józef Piłsudski.
During the Nazi encirclement of Warsaw, he was
among the defenders of the city.
Following the fall of Warsaw, already dressed in
civilian clothes, he was deported to Czechia
along with a large number of Poles, and from
there to the sorrowfully notorious Ciechanów
camp. Afterwards, he was in Częstochowa.
During the mass slaughters and “resettlements”
in 1942 in Częstochowa, he was deported to
Treblinka, where he perished in sanctification of
the Name [of God] and the People [of Israel], at
the hands of the Nazi murderers.
