NEUFELD Natalia Anastazja (1887–1920), doctor. She was born on 2nd November 1887 in Częstochowa, the daughter of \rightarrow Maurycy Neufeld and Klara née Sachs (1863-1919), the sister of \rightarrow Stanisław and Wanda (\rightarrow Wanda Kopecka).

She completed her medical studies (circa 1911), specialising in childhood illnesses and internal medicine. She worked in the hospital of the "Dobroczynność" Charitable Society for Jews in Zawodzie, Częstochowa. She ran a private medical practice at II Aleja 26 and, after 1918, at I Aleja 10.

In December 1918, at a meeting of the Częstochowa municipal authorities, she was appointed as a doctor of Jewish schools in Częstochowa. In December 1919, she opened an analytical laboratory at II Aleja 33.

She died on 2nd January 1920 in Częstochowa, after contracting typhus from a patient. She was buried in the local Jewish cemetery.

She did not establish a family.
