RAJCHMAN (REICHMAN) Salomon (circa 1872-1942), entrepreneur, charitable activist.

From at least 1898, Rajchman was co-owner (initially, with his brother Józef and Izrael Zychman) of a sawmill at ul. Tartakowa 15. He also owned a timberyard at ul. Teatralna 12 (Kościuszki).

He was active in charitable works. From the start of the 20th century, he belonged to the "Dobroczynność" Charitable Society for Jews. From 1917, he was president of the Support Section of Poor School Youth at the Society for the Spreading of Knowledge.

He perished in 1942 at Treblinka.

His wife was Bela née Bromberg. The couple had a son \rightarrow Władysław Wolf, as well as daughters, one of whom represented the Support Section of Poor School Youth in its contacts with the authorities. In 1914-1921, Regina belonged to the board of the Society for the Spreading of Knowledge.
