

RAJCHMAN (Reichman) Władysław Wolf (1896?-1942), lawyer. He was born in Częstochowa, the son of → Salomon and Bela née Bromberg.

In 1926, he completed his court training and, in 1927, he was accepted as a trainee lawyer based in Częstochowa. From 1930, he was included in the list of lawyers in Częstochowa, conducting his legal practice at I Aleja 6 (later at ul. Dąbrowskiego 7).

From 1928, he served on the board of the Association of Jewish Secondary Schools in Częstochowa, which ran the local Jewish Gimnazjum.

During the German occupation, he was forced to live in the Częstochowa ghetto. When the deportation of the Jewish populace from the ghetto took place (September-October 1942, he was deported to the Treblinka extermination camp, where he perished in October 1942.
