

ROSENBERG (ROZENBERG) Filip Fiszel (1854-), industrialist, social activist. He was born on 16th December 1854 in Piotrków Trybunalski, the son of Jakub and Itta Liba née Laks.

Rosenberg was the owner of the Limestone Plants and the “Saturn” Tar and Asphalt Factory. (The office was located at II Aleja 16). Together with his wife, he belonged to the “Dobroczynność” Charitable Society for Jews.

He lived at ul. Aleksandrowska (Wilsona) 8.

In 1879, he married Helena Chaja née Imich (23rd December 1859 Częstochowa -), the daughter of Herszlik, a merchant, and Rozalia née Pankowska who, during World War I, was a volunteer in the No. 2 kitchen of the Jewish section of Emergency Aid.

They had three children:

- Jakub (2nd March 1882 Częstochowa -), an engineer,
- Abram Dawid (15th June 1888 Częstochowa -) a bank clerk, and
- Janina (5th October 1897 Częstochowa -).
