**ROZENBAUM** (ROSENBAUM) Izrael (1859–1927), landowner, merchant. He was born on 12<sup>th</sup> May 1859 in Podświerk, a hamlet in the village of Cadów, in the Kobiele Wielkie council area. He was the son of Eliasz and Sora Rywka née Ferszter.

From 1893, in Błeszno in the gmina Huta Stara (now a part of Częstochowa), he was engaged in the timber trade. From 1906, he was the owner of the Błeszno estate, which he had bought from  $\rightarrow$  Jakub Rotszyld. In Bleszno, he also ran a wholesale timber yard.

In Częstochowa, he lived at II Aleja 31. He died on 29<sup>th</sup> March 1927 in Częstochowa and was buried in the local Jewish cemetery.

He married Chaja Sura née Markowicz (1860 Częstochowa - 10<sup>th</sup> January 1931 Częstochowa), the daughter of Szaja and Laja née Braun. The had eleven children:
