STOBIECKI Dawid (1904-1939), lawyer. He was born on 24th November 1904 in Częstochowa, the son of Herszlik and Ajdla née Kromołowska.

Stobiecki, graduating from law studies, on 12^{th} October 1931, he was appointed as an intern by the Appeals Court in Warsaw. At the beginning of 1934, he was entered on the list of intern lawyers, under the patronage of the well-known civil lawyer \rightarrow Mieczysław Mendel Konarski in Częstochowa.

In March 1938, he passed the examination at the Warsaw Law Association and gained the title of lawyer. He opened his chambers in Częstochowa at pl. Daszyńskiego 11. In June 1938, he moved them to ul. Berka Joselewicza 13, to a new building (opposite the Hat Factory), where he practised law until the outbreak of the War.

On 21st April 1939, he was appointed liquidator of the Częstochowa Craftsmen's Co-operative Bank.

At the beginning of September 1939, he died in an explosion caused by a bomb dropped, in Kielce, by the Germans.

His wife was Lucyna née Turner who, after 1945, lived in Israel. They had one child.
