SZWARZ (Szwarc) Abram Adolf (1882–), doctor. He was born 9^{th} November 1882 in Częstochowa, the son of Izydor Izrael and Cyrla Celinya née Eksztajn, the brother of \rightarrow Dawid.

He graduated from the Russian Boy's Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. In 1900-1905, he studied medicine at the Russian University of Warsaw. In 1906, he graduated in medicine at the Jurjewski University in Dorpat (Tartu). In 1939, as an ophthalmologist, he ran a medical practice in Warsaw (living at ul. Żulińskiego 6).

Szwarz was married twice. His first wife was Natalia née Majzner (27th February 1884 Warsaw-), then to Domicela née Lipców (23rd January 1886 Warsaw-).
