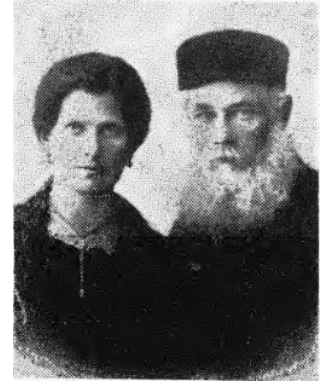


We immortalise the memory of our dear parents:
