memory of our beloved parents,

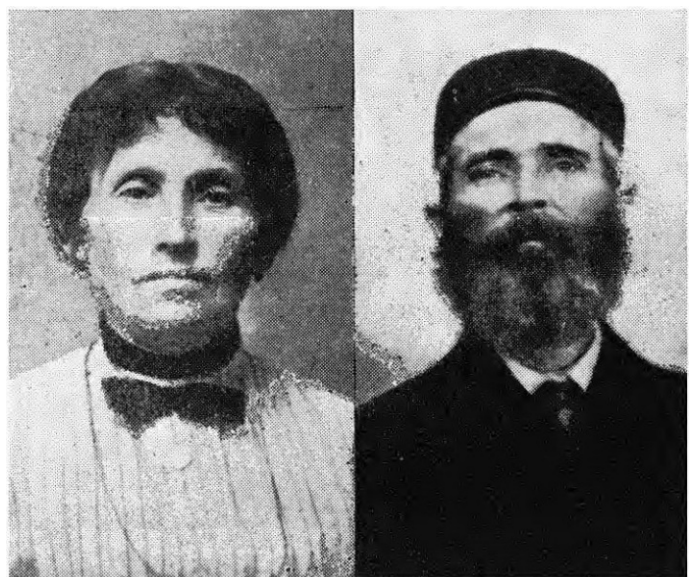
Reb **Józef Boruch** (son of Reb Rubin *z''l*),
