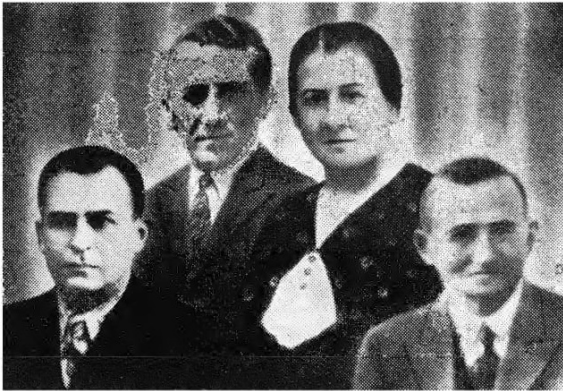


For Eternal Remembrance
