Reb **Uziel-Zvi** (Hersz) **Gancwajch** *hy''d*, (the grandson of the renowned rabbi, **Rabbi Izraił-Lajb Gancwajch** *z''l*) the extremely assiduous [Torah] studier, and disciple of the Prodigy of Ostrowiec *ztz''l*¹.

And following his marriage in 1893 with **Rywka-Brajndla** z"l, the only daughter of Reb **Henech** and **Ester Jozewer** of Częstochowa, he studied the Torah for its own sake during many years, even when he was already a great military contractor.
