Our grandfather z"l

Our grandfather, Reb **Natan-Nuta-Izaak** son of Reb Szlojme Zvi [Hersz] **Tyberg** z"l, died at a ripe old age in Częstochowa, on the Eve of the 1st of Elul 5694 [11/8/1934].

Our grandmother, Mrs **Rywka Ruchel** daughter of Reb Mojsze Aron Tenenbaum z"l, died in Częstochowa on 23rd Elul 5672 [5/9/1912].


Our father, Reb **Dawid Dov [Berek]** son of Reb Natan-Nuta-Izaak Tyberg, made Aliyahin 5695 [1935] and died in Rehovot on 3rd Sivan 5710 [19/5/1950].

Our mother, **Fajga Laja** daughter of Reb Mojsze Chaim Szterling, made Aliyah in 5695 [1935], and died in Rehovot on 20th Elul 5712 [10/9/1952].

By the tomb of our grandfather z''I in Częstochowa stood also our brother **Izrael** z''I, who died in a working accident in the Land [of Israel], on 20^{th} Cheshvan 5698 [25/10/1937]. And by the tomb of our grandmother z''I in Częstochowa stood also our brother **Jakub** z''I, who died in Petah Tikva on 9^{th} Tevet 5720 [9/1/1960].

Their name shall forever be remembered, and their memory shall not fade from us!
