URBACH Michał (1806-1888), doctor. He was born in Działoszyn.

He practised in Warsaw. In 1847, he moved from Warsaw to Częstochowa, from where he periodically left to practise Zgierz (including in 1851, 1854, 1856 and 1858). In the "Kurier Warszawski", his patients published a "thank you" to him for their treatment.

From 1868, he lived in Łódź where, on 13th May 1888, he died and was buried in the local Old Jewish Cemetery (on ul. Zachodnia).
