

**WAJNBERG** Antoni Józef (1911-1942), trainee lawyer. He was born on 27<sup>th</sup> September 1911 in Częstochowa, the son of Mošek (1873 Częstochowa-) and Helena née Moszkowicz (1876 Częstochowa-).

In 1929, Wajnberg matriculated from the R. Traugutt No.2 State Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. After completing his legal studies, he became a trainee lawyer under the patronage of → Eliaz Krauskopf in Częstochowa. In the spring of 1938, he applied to be admitted as a practising lawyer.

During the German occupation, he was forced to live in the ghetto in Częstochowa. He was transported from the ghetto (between 24<sup>th</sup> September and 4<sup>th</sup> October 1942) to the extermination camp in Treblinka, where he was murdered.
