WAJNBERG Antoni Józef (1911-1942), trainee lawyer. He was born on 27th September 1911 in Częstochowa, the son of Mośek (1873 Częstochowa-) and Helena née Moszkowicz (1876 Częstochowa-).

In 1929, Wajnberg matriculated from the R. Traugutt No.2 State Gimnazjum in Częstochowa. After completing his legal studies, he became a trainee lawyer under the patronage of \rightarrow Eliasz Krauskopf in Częstochowa. In the spring of 1938, he applied to be admitted as a practising lawyer.

During the German occupation, he was forced to live in the ghetto in Częstochowa. He was transported from the ghetto (between 24th September and 4th October 1942) to the extermination camp in Treblinka, where he was murdered.
