

WAJNREB (WAINREB) Moszek (1799-1847), merchant, tenant farmer. He lived in Częstochowa, at ul. Kozia 191).

Together with → Dawid Bergman he leased the Aniołów farm (now within the city of Częstochowa, in the Wyczerpy-Aniołów district).

In 1842, in Aniołów, where he lived after selling the house on ul. Kozia to Herszlik Goldman, in the presence of notary Ignacy Budrewicz and four witnesses from Częstochowa, he made a will in which he appointed his wife Jetta and brother-in-law Dawid Bergman as guardians of his children. He also bequeathed 120 rubles to Lewek Epstein and his daughter.

He died on 5th September 1847 in Aniołów.

Wajnreb was married three times:

- to Rachla née Oderfeld, with whom he had a daughter Rozalia
- to Estera née Oderfeld (Rachla's sister) and
- to Jetta née Goldman, with whom he had five children:
 - Hana,
 - Dyna,
 - Ewa (Chewa),
 - Szymon Herszlik
 - Mindla.
