

WIZENTAL (WIZENTHAL) Józef (circa 1885-), railway official, city councillor, social activist.

In Częstochowa, he worked as a clerk in the Warsaw-Vienna Railway.

He was involved in the work of the Society for the Spreading of Knowledge. He served as its librarian, creating a catalogue of its collections. He served on its board (in 1910-1911), as well as on the audit committee (in 1914).

In 1917, he entered the City Council in the district elections. Until March 1918, he was deputy secretary and a member of the Finance-Budget Committee and of the Food Committee. He later announced his resignation to the Council's executive. On the City Council, he was replaced by → Samuel Schlichter.

Wizental moved to Noworadomsko (Radomsko), where he became a member of the School Council.
