WOLLENBERG Maurycy (1880–1942), photographer, photographic studio owner. He was born on 2nd May 1880 in Koniń, the son of Beniamin (1844 Częstochowa – 1906 Częstochowa), photographer and Augusta Gusta Gołda née Gumpricht (1849-1942).

From 1912 to 1924, he owned the "Apollo" photographic studio in Częstochowa. Until 1940, the "Stella" [studio] at II Aleja 33 belonged to the Wollenbergs.

Together with his wife and mother, he was murdered by the Germans on 22nd September 1942 in Częstochowa. There is a symbolic inscription on a grave (No. 8 III) in the Częstochowa Jewish Cemetery.

His wife was Stefania Szprynca [née] Rotner (2nd July VII 1888 Częstochowa – 1942), the daughter of Szmul Ruwen Rotner and Salomea née Śpiewak.

Juliusz Sętowski, Wiesław Paszkowski
